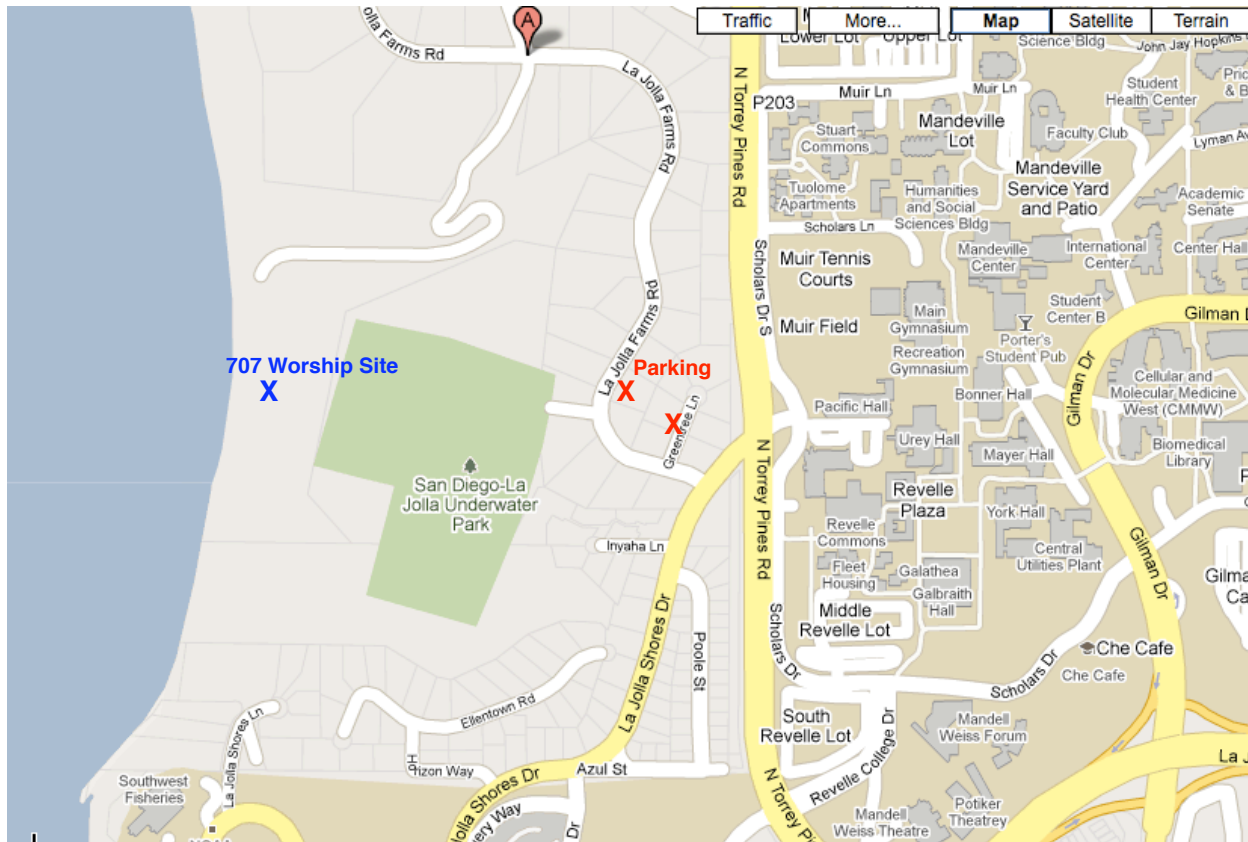
Thank You!

Map and Directions to Early Easter Service!



Head for North Torrey Pines Road. La Jolla Village Drive becomes this road if you're traveling east to west.

Turn left on La Jolla Shores Drive and right on La Jolla Farms Rd.

There is some parking available on La Jolla Farms Rd (though not much), as well as on Greentree Lane (which is the first right once you turn on La Jolla Farms, before you hit the park entrance).

Between the parking areas and the service area is a dirt path, roughly 1/2 mile (maybe less).
