Family Camp – a time to kick back and enjoy the fellowship of the Good Sam Family in a peaceful fun filled setting. A private campground located in the Cuyamaca Mountains at an elevation of 4,000 feet, this 140-acre preserve is covered with oak trees and Manzanita shrubbery.

We have 10 RV sites reserved. Each site can accommodate 1 RV and 1 tent or up to 3 tents for a maximum of 10 people per site. The cost is \$32 per RV site per night. There is a day use fee of \$5 per vehicle for those that want to come up on Saturday only. Breakfast is available at the campground for a nominal fee Sat. and Sun. mornings giving the regular family cooks some time off. We will organize a potluck for Saturday evening.
