Benjamin Britten wrote War Requiem for the consecration of the rebuilt Coventry Cathedral, which had been destroyed in World War II. "My subject is war, and the pity of war," wrote poet Wilfred Owen, and the War Requiem fuses Owen's war poems with the Latin Mass for the Dead. Britten scores this moving music for monumental forces: boys choir, organ, chorus, three soloists, a chamber orchestra, and symphony orchestra.
